Recalling further that the implementation of the Executive Council's decision requires the appointment of two (2) auditors from Member-States in the Commission to audit the funds made available to the Regional Secretariat for Asia and the Pacific,

Having taken note of the views expressed by the Philippine delegation regarding their preference to retain the prerogatives of audit and control over their financial contribution towards the operations of the Regional Secretariat,

### Decides the following:

- (a) that only the funds emanating from the WTO Programme Eudget, which are derived from Members' contributions, and made available to the Regional Secretariat, shall be subject to audit by the Commission's designated Member-States auditors;
- (b) that the Commission's designated auditors are Republic of Korea and Thailand, whose terms of office shall cover the financial period 1978-1979;
- (c) that the Regional Secretary make available on or about July 15, 1979 the books of accounts and other supporting documents covering the financial transactions for the period January 1, 1978 to June 30, 1979 for the examination and audit of the auditors.
