The Commission,

Decides to nominate People's Republic of China to the Vice Presidency, Philippines to the Administrative Committee, Republic of Korea to the Technical Committee, and to suggest to the President of the Assembly, Indonesia as a Member of the Credentials Committee.

Decides further to nominate Australia to the Administrative Committee on Affiliate Members and Japan to the Committee on Statistics, subject to the approval of the General Assembly at its sixth session on the establishment of the aforementioned Committees as subsidiary organs of the Executive Council.
