- 1. <u>Appreciates</u> the decision of the forty-fourth session of the Organization's Executive Council to open a Support Office in Asia which will enable the Secretariat to provide more efficient services to the Members;
- 2. <u>Urges</u> the Secretariat to provide information about the structure of the office, manpower requirements and other details to the Members who have expressed interest in hosting the Office;
- 3. <u>Notes</u> the views of the Members that it is too late in the year to efficiently plan and implement the activities for East Asia Tourism Year 1994;
- 4. <u>Decides</u> that a final decision about East Asia Tourism Year should be taken at the twenty-fifth meeting of the Commission which is scheduled to be held in conjunction with the tenth General Assembly of the Organization;
- 5. Agrees with the suggestion that Members can draw good lessons from the experience of the Visit ASEAN Year 1992;
- 6. <u>Urges</u> the Secretariat to study and analyze the outcome of other regional years and submit a report at its twenty-fifth meeting; and
- 7. <u>Hopes</u> that in light of the new UNDP policy for project execution, the Organization's technical assistance will continue to be extended to the Members of the Region.

2. <u>The Commission</u> adopted a motion, proposed by Malaysia and endorsed by all the Members, to express its sincere gratitude to the Government of Philippines for excellent arrangements made for the meeting and for extending a warm welcome and hospitality to the delegates.
