REPORT ON THE ORGANIZATION'S EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMME OF WORK

Having heard the presentation made by the Secretariat,

- 1. <u>Thanks</u> the Secretariat for its presentation;
- 2. <u>Recognizes</u> that the new age of tourism is characterized by the supersegmentation of demand and that tourism education and training should increasingly respond to the requirements of these demands;
- 3. <u>Further recognizes</u> that WTO's mission in this area is to achieve quality in tourism education and training and that the method of total quality management should be adopted in achieving this mission;
- 4. <u>Encourages</u> the Secretariat to continue to develop new education and training instruments such as the TEDQUAL, the GTAT as well as to implement other activities including the proposed WTO Ulysses Awards, internship programmes and WTO education and training website; and
- 5. <u>Urges</u> the Secretariat to designate a WTO Education and Training Centre in the Asian region.
