

Business Travellers against Human Trafficking is a project created by Oasis and ECPAT Belgium to help in the fight against human trafficking by specifically informing and equipping Business Travellers to be advocates for change instead of being part of the problem.

Business travellers can sometimes abuse children and use trafficked children as prostitutes.

Most business travellers are horrified by this behaviour and can be a powerful lobby for change. Business people are valued customers for hotels. If they are mobilised to ask hotels for higher standards of action against the exploitation of children, then their voice will be listened to.




Business Travellers against Human Trafficking exists to;

Raise awareness amongst the business travel community about human trafficking

Provide a place via our website for people to report what they have seen if they are uncomfortable with approaching the police locally.

Ask hotels to improve their standards of conduct with regard to ending child exploitation and stopping traffickers exploiting their victims at hotels.

Business Travellers are also given the opportunity to give money to projects helping children vulnerable to human trafficking.





What has happened so far?

Building support

Business people around the world are joining.

The European Parliament has recommended the campaign in a recent report on trafficking by the MEP Christa Prets.

30 MEPs have signed to specifically support the initiative.

The EU Parliament's FEMM Gender committee has committed its support to the campaign.

18 MEPs sent a letter to the government of UAE about the trafficking of women and children in that country on behalf of Business Travellers against Human Trafficking.
