Jiangsu Province:

- ♦ as the pilot
- ♦ the year of reference 2002
- ♦ lasting 3 years (07/ 2001—09/ 2004)
- ◆ Tourism Value-added making up 4.2% of GDP
- ◆ Proportion of tourism employment 8.54%

Zhejiang Province:

- the second compiling province
- ♦ the year of reference 2004
- ◆ lasting 2 years (05/2004—06/2006)
- ◆ Tourism Value-added making up 4.81% of GDP
- Proportion of tourism employment5.37%

Beijing Municipality:

- ♦ the year of reference 2004
- ♦ lasting 2 years (05/2006—10/2008)
- ◆ Tourism Value-added making up 6.7% of GDP
- Proportion of tourism employment 11.7%

National study:

- ♦ the year of reference 2004
- ◆Major tables have been compiled
- ◆ Tourism value added made up 4.05% of GDP
