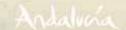

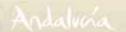

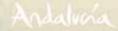

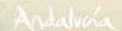

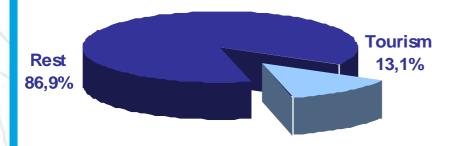

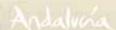


GDP Tourism Share in Andalusia. Year 2000.

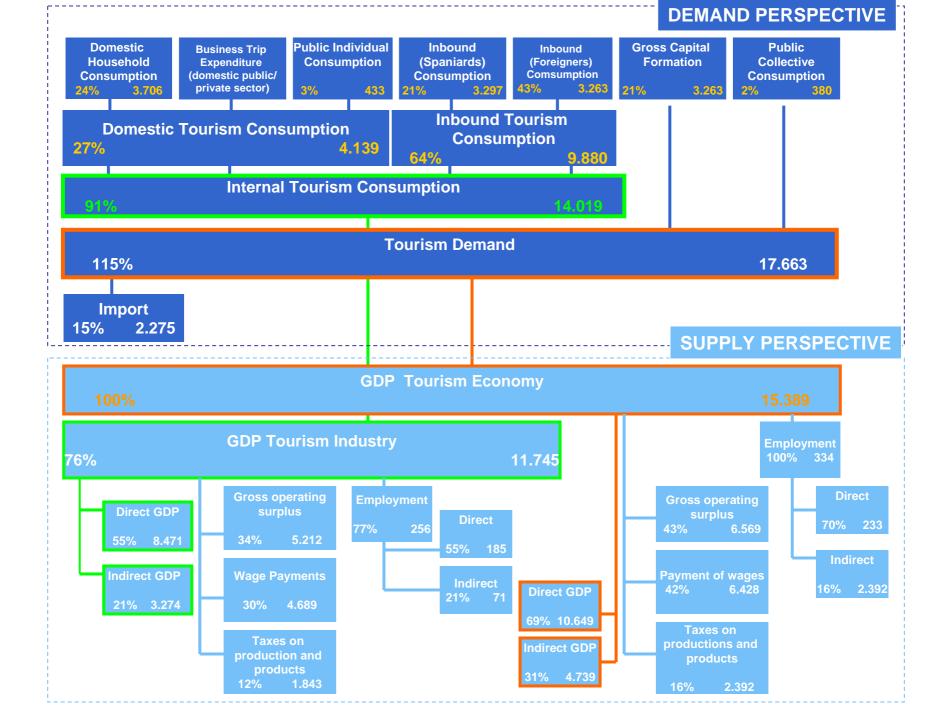

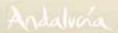
Share of tourist consumption on final consumption of Andalucia: 20%
