





















Conclusions



- Domestic tourism still showing an increasing trend, new record marks;
- Less German tourists, but still the most important guests;
- Winter season 2009/10 only with a slight decrease related nights, but a record mark related arrivals;
- **Summer season** 2010 with the highest overnights since 1995, and a record mark related arrivals; urban tourism is recovering;
- **Holiday trips** still popular, in particular short-term trips in Austria; decreasing prices (i.e. packages, fuel);
- Near destinations popular, long-distance holidays less frequent;
- Trend towards non-rental accommodation (i.e. VFR, 2nd homes);
- International tourism receipts decreasing, international tourism expenditure remain rather stable in 2009;



...so far, Austrian tourism less concerned by the economic/ financial crisis than expected!
