Survey of the tourist trips of residents and the tourism–related expenditures

Aims of the Survey

- Harmonization of Tourism statistics in Bulgaria with the requirements of the EU
- Comparison the data from the survey with data from other EU – countries

Aims of the Survey

- Data on the trips of the residents to the country and abroad
- Data on expenditures of the residents
- Data for TSA

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Methodology of the Survey

- The Methodology is in compliance with the EU legislation in the field of tourism
- The Methodology is in compliance with the International Recommendation on Tourism Statistics of the WTO

Object and Coverage of the Survey

- Sample survey Representative sample to the country
- Respondents the people of 15 years age and over in the households get into the sample

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Sample design

- Two stages stratified cluster sample:
- The clusters of the first stage are the enumeration districts.
- The clusters of the second stage are households

Sample design

 With probability proportional to the size of districts population 2250 enumeration districts are chosen, within which 8 households are systematically selected. The scheme of constant number of households selected in each second stage cluster ensures an equal burden of interviewers

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Sample size

- The sample includes 3 000 households
- o 5 500 people of 15 years age and over
- The sample is designed by regions, separately for urban and rural population

Statistical tools

- Questionnaires for the households
- Instructions for Questionnaires

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Questionnaire

- o Three parts are included
- General section age of person, education, social status and the reasons for not travel
- 2. Holiday trips only the last trip
- 3. Business trips only the last trip

Main indicators

- The main reason for the trip
- The kind of transport
- The kind of accommodation
- o Number of nights spend
- The cost of the trip
- Specification of the expenditures-food, accommodation and etc.

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Work organization-1

- o The tasks of Regional Statistical Offices:
- Data collection by interview face to face
- Data checking for fullness and errors

Work organization-2

- o The tasks of Regional Statistical Offices:
- Coding of the questionnaires where is necessary
- Data entry to the PC

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Work organization

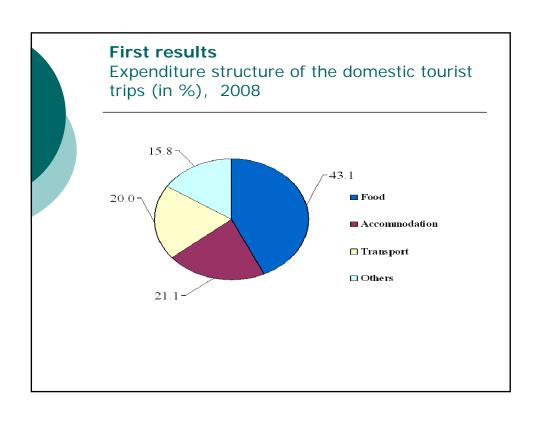
- The tasks of NSI

Type of expenditure	Domestic
Total	133.8
Food	57.2
Accommodation	28.4
Transport	26.8
Others	21.4

- o Reference period: Quarters
- Period of data collection 2 weeks after the reference period
