Tourists and Visitors on borders

The survey is conducted on borders crossing and it provides basic characteristics of <u>tourists</u> and <u>same-day visitors</u>:

- country of residence
- lengths of stay
- organisation and purpose of visit,
- accommodation used,
- expenditures prior and during the visit,
- components of expenditures (accommodation, transportation, shopping, services etc).



Administration

Institution in charge – Department of Tourism, Ministry of Sport and Tourism

<u>Unit responsible for research</u> – Institute of Tourism in Warsaw

Other institution involved - National Bank of Poland



<u>Frequency</u> – eight times a year (two times in each quarter)

- reference period for the first procedure –
 February of given year
- reference period for the last procedure conducted_— December of given year

<u>Frame</u> – sample of border points (crossings). Type of enumeration – face to face interviews on exit.

Sampling – about 2 x 18000 questionnaires a year (tourists and one-day visitors).

<u>Distribution of the sample over time</u> – eight waves yearly, from Feb to Dec, each wave about one week long.



<u>Data collection principles</u> – systematic sampling (each Nth person is interviewed, the N depends on type of border).

Geographical breakdown - country of residence

Other issues – in addition, a counting and estimating of border flows is being conducted




Results of the research - Structure of tourists' expenditures in 2008

Results of the research




- During 2008 there were:
- Nearly 60 million arrivals (by 9% less).
- The number of tourist arrivals is estimated for this time at some 13 mill (by 13% less).
