Improvement in data collection in 2 main border posts (1 airport and 1 mainland border post) – Pilot phase IT system optical reading of passport

Geographical coverage: 15 border posts (4 airports and 11 mainland border posts)

Expenditure Survey

Improvement in the questionnaire adress to measure:

- Same day visitor
- Nigths spent in each place of accomodation

Geographical coverage: 12 border posts (4 airports and 8 mainland border posts)

Household survey (Domestic Module)

- Finalized data processing;
- Data Cleaning concluded;
