Employment in the TSA



IRTS (2008) on Measuring Employment

- "It is unlikely that a complete picture of employment in the tourism industries can be obtained from a statistical source" (p68)
- These include:
 - Household based sample survey;
 - Establishment based sample survey; and,
 - Administrative records



Sources in Australia

- Australian Labour Force Survey is the key data source
 - Most industries
- Also establishment based survey for selected industries (Annual Integrated Collections)
 - Service industries



Methodology

- Australian TSA estimates direct tourism employment
- Tourism value added ratios applied to employment estimates
 - assumes employment is proportional to value added
- Some tourism industries are combined (accuracy)



Future directions

- Improved labour input measures in future TSAs
- Part-time/ Full-time split for employment
 - 10/11 release
- · Hours worked



Other partial measures

- TSA is only one source of employment information:
- Labour Force Survey
- Census 2011
- Others (DEEWR small area unemployment)
