- Ministry of Tourism (MOT):
 - To have an idea about the other competitive Destinations in the World.

Main Users of Outbound Tourism Statistics (contd.)

- Reserve Bank of India:
 - To have a consistency check with the balance of payment figures from tourism in the balance of payment statistics.

Main Users of Outbound Tourism Statistics (contd.)

- Ministry of External Affairs:
 - In drafting various bilateral and multilateral treaties with other countries of the World.

Data Gaps in existing Outbound Tourism Statistics:

- Country wise break up of Indian National Departures for the year 2009 is not yet available.
- Details like purpose of visit etc. are not available.

Initiatives by MOT

 No of outbound statistics are collected through embarkation card and only no of outbound Indians are compiled. Now the card has been revised to capture the age, sex, purpose of visit, destination, etc. through the cards.

Initiatives by MOT

- International Passenger Survey:
 - To have details about the Outbound Indians regarding the Country of destinations, expenditure abroad, etc. IPS has been commissioned to ISI, Kolkata.
 - Field Work of the survey started in January, 2010 and is likely to be over in January, 2011.
 - Report likely to come in March 2012.
 - The results of this survey will be used in the preparation of 2nd Tourism Satellite Account of India.

Steps taken after the 1st Workshop

• Tabulation Plan for International Passenger Survey outlining the details of purpose of visit, expenditure pattern abroad, average duration of stay, etc. of Indian National Departures finalized.

Steps taken after the 1st Workshop

• Matters are being pursued with the authorities for compiling the details of Indian National Departures according to purpose of visit, mode of travel, etc.
