- Provides a regular and timely overview of NZ's labour force
- © Civilian, non-institutionalised aged 15 years and over
- 15,000 private households, 30,000 individuals
- Rural and urban areas
- Excludes long-term residents of hospitals, psychiatric institutions, armed and non armed defence personnel and overseas diplomats
- Targeted response rate

2) Quarterly Employment Survey (QES)

- Estimates of change in and levels of:
 - > average hourly and average weekly (pre tax) earnings
 - > average weekly paid hours
 - > number of jobs filled
- 18,000 business locations from a range of industries and regions
- Targeted response rate
- All business locations owned by economically significant enterprises in surveyed industries that employ staff.

2) Quarterly Employment Survey (QES) continued...

Economically significant?

- Greater than \$30,000 annual GST expenses or sales
- GST exempt industry
- New GST registration that is compulsory, special or forced
- Registered for GST and involved in agriculture or forestry
- Has at least three for its rolling mean employment
- Part of a group of enterprises
