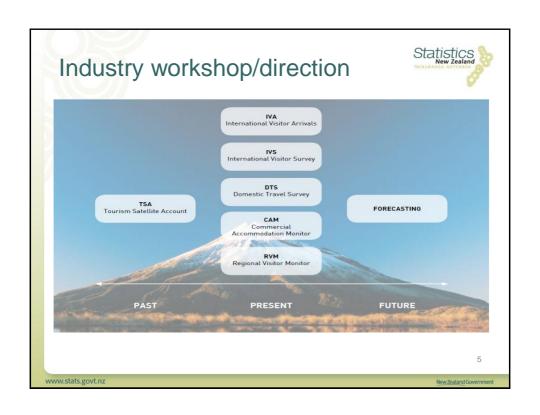

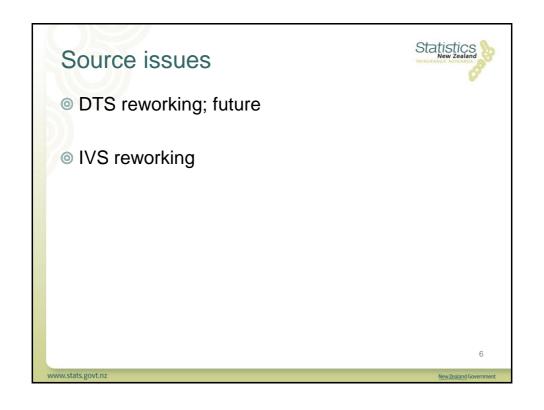

Point of interest: Impact of GST increase on Tourism

- Product = \$100 excl GST; Retails for \$112.50
- At 15% product would retail for \$115.00
- Measuring this change:
- > Percentage point increase = 2.5
- > GST revenue increase = \$2.50 increase or 20%
- > Retail price increase = 2.2%

Note: Not all goods and services consumed by tourists are subject to GST and thus the overall price increase would be slightly lower

Tourist type impact:

Domestic tourist demand

- i. potentially neutral
- ii. any alteration to tourist expenditure behaviour could be offset by changes to income tax brackets

International tourist demand

- i. difficult to determine
- ii. multiple assumptions and influences
