



Introduction


- Fiji Bureau of Statistics Collection of Administrative Data is managed by Tourism and Migration Unit
- ➤ Department of Immigration Arrival and Departure cards [main source]
 - . Cards are processed and recorded by border officers [PLO]
 - . System is maintained by ITC Services
 - . Data is then provided to FBOS as "RAW" data

FBOS Overseas Arrivals and Departures methodology of data collection

of Statistics

- All Residents are required to fill departure cards
- Cards are then collected by Border Officers [PLO]
- PLO process and then record the cards on-line
- ITC Services provides FBOS with Occupation corrections [edit]
- Flights are balanced and processed when corrections done
- Raw Data [converted using SAS to produce tables].



- Status in Fiji









Data Dissemination

- Monthly and Annual data released by Fiji Bureau of Statistics
- 2 months behind [2011 data released on February 29, 2012], 2007 -2010 Annual Report [circulation]
- Published data consists of :
 - . Country of Residence
 - . Average Length of Stay
 - . Race, Sex and Age
 - . Purpose of Visit
 - . Destination
 - . Purpose of Absence
 - . Occupation
 - . Emigration
 - . Last and next port of call

Challenges and Development

- Maintaining good relationship with stakeholders
- Maintaining high quality sources of tourism and migration statistics and producing timely reports.
- Upgrade of the Immigration system from VAX [1986 2004] to ORACLE before 1986 it was manually done.
- Use of FISCO 95 [Fiji Standard Classification of Occupations] in 2005, prior to 2005 [FCDO 1975] Fiji Classification and Dictionary of Occupations] was in use.

Issues in not releasing timely data

- Inconsistent support from key stakeholders both in Government and Statutory Bodies
- More awareness [stakeholders to know how important the data is].
