1. Place and dates of the Congress

The First UNWTO International Congress on Tourism and Pilgrimages will be held from 17 - 20 September 2014 in Santiago de Compostela, Spain. The sessions of the Congress will take place at the Parador of Santiago de Compostela (http://www.parador.es/es/parador-de-santiago-de-compostela). The opening ceremony, which will be followed by an opening speech, will take place on Wednesday, 17 September 2014, at 17:30, at the Parador of Santiago de Compostela.

5. Access to Santiago de Compostela

The city of Santiago de Compostela is located in the north-west of Spain, 600 km from Madrid. The map below shows the historical itineraries of the Way of St. James. It also situates the city within Europe.



Several airlines operate direct flights (some daily) from major European airports to the **Santiago de Compostela Airport**.

Participants can also choose to fly to nearby airports (see map below) such as Vigo and A Coruña.



Journey time in taxi from the different Galician airports to the city centre of Santiago de Compostela:

- Santiago de Compostela
 Airport / city centre: 15 minutes
 by taxi (approximately 20€).
 20 minutes by bus (5.10 €
 return bus ticket)
- A Coruña Airport / Santiago de Compostela: 45 minutes by taxi. 1h18 by train.
- Vigo Airport / Santiago de Compostela: 60 minutes by car. 1h30 by train.



12. Practical information

- Local currency and exchange rates: The official currency of Spain is the euro (EUR). The exchange rate applicable as of 1 July 2014 is approximately 1.37 USD to 1 EUR.
 - Banks are open Monday to Friday from 8:30 to 14:00. Exchange offices can be found all around Santiago, and are clearly marked. Currency exchange services are also available at the hotels. ATMs are widely available around the city and shops accept major credit cards.
- Weather: In September, Santiago de Compostela enjoys mild days and fresh nights. The average maximum temperature is 21 °C and the average minimum is 11 °C. It may rain.
- Official languages: Spanish and Galician.
- Local time in Santiago de Compostela (summer): GMT +2
- Electricity: Electric power in Santiago de Compostela is 220 volts, 50 hertz alternating current. Outlets take plugs with two round pins. In any case, most hotels have adaptors for different plug types. Please make sure that the electrical devices you will be using (computers, mobile phone chargers, electric shavers...) are suitable for this voltage, otherwise transformers or batteries are advisable.
- Health requirements and precautions: No vaccinations are required to enter Spain.

- Medical services: Santiago de Compostela has a good network of health centres (primary care services) and hospitals. The venue of the meeting will have a medical service providing first aid.
- Optional visits: There will be a travel agency desk at the Parador of Santiago de Compostela (see Annex 1).

Galicia is a destination that surprises visitors. The variety and unique character of the tourism options in this corner of northern Spain provide visitors with an opportunity to enjoy many "travel experiences" that are exclusive to this destination and which are located throughout the territory of the region.

In Galicia, a traveller can feel the incomparable experience of reaching the ultimate destination of the "Way of St. James", or the unique sensation of freedom when strolling through the region's "Lighthouses and Natural Beaches", where one can enjoy the beauty of virgin beaches, many of which are near lighthouses that were built in spectacular locations, such as Fisterra—one of the most emblematic sites in the mythic history of Galicia—or in nature parks such as that of Illas Cíes.

The mysteries hidden within the "Forests of Galicia" lead visitors through truly magical natural environments, which in turn also allow you to discover monasteries, stone crosses, forts and other architectural gems that make up the "Hidden Heritage" of Galicia. Some of these experiences are of a unique nature such as the World Heritage sites of the Old Town of Santiago de Compostela, the Roman Walls of Lugo and the Tower of Hercules in A Coruña.

Speaking of unique places, the "Ribeira Sacra", represents one of Europe's greatest concentrations of monasteries, in the middle of a lush natural space. Or "Ferrol of the Enlightenment", the only military port in Europe that preserves the original structure of a military port of that era and was the largest naval base of the time.

Galicia offers vertiginous landscapes by the sea, such as the "Serra da Capelada", where you can climb cliffs that reach 620 meters high, as well as breathtaking views such as the panorama from "Santa Tegra" where the largest pre-Roman fort in the north-western Iberian Peninsula is located.

There are many "experiences" that Galicia offers visitors, and this is a unique opportunity to enjoy them.
