UNWTO Regional Capacity Building Course on Cultural Tourism Product Development

Doha, Qatar, 21-25 September 2014

I. PLACE AND DATE

- 1. The World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) and the Qatar Tourism Authority (QTA) are convening a regional capacity building course on **Cultural Tourism Product Development** for the Middle East and North Africa, to be held in Doha, **from 21 to 25 September 2014**. This regional capacity building activity is addressed to high level decision-makers in the National and Local Tourism Administration with competences in the design, implementation and monitoring of destination level tourism development strategy.
- 2. The course will be held at Al Mirqab Hotel, Souk Waqif Boutique Hotels
- 3. The course will be held on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, from 8.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.

II. REPLIES TO INVITATIONS

4. Participants are kindly requested to confirm their participation by registering online at https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/QTR14-2 Appli, as soon as possible and no later than 5 September 2014.

III. STATUS OF PARTICIPANTS

5. The Government of Qatar will take the necessary measures to facilitate the arrival, stay and departure of participants invited by the Organization, as well as to facilitate their stay in Qatar. Throughout their stay, participants will benefit from the privileges and immunities provided for in the Agreement concluded between the Organization and QTA, under article 32 of the Statute of the Organization.

IV. RECEPTION

6. The Qatari Authorities will organize the reception of participants at **Hamad International Airport** and will facilitate the free transfer of delegates on arrival and on departure between the airport, the selected hotels and the venue of the meeting.

V. ENTRY FORMALITIES

- 7. A valid passport is necessary for visitors coming to Qatar.
- 8. All nationalities would require an entry visa except for the Gulf Countries nationals (GCC). Delegates who require an entry visa are requested to contact diplomatic or consular missions of Qatar in their countries in order to obtain their entry visas.
- 9. QTA will be glad to assist officials in issuing their visas once they have been accepted by UNWTO. Once accepted, selected international participants requiring an entry visa, will need to send to QTA (Mr. Sharif Massouh: industry@qatartourism.gov.qa) a scanned copy of their passport valid for at least 6 months, together with their travel information (date, time and flight number), by 31 August 2014, at the latest.

VI. <u>ACCOMMODATION</u>
