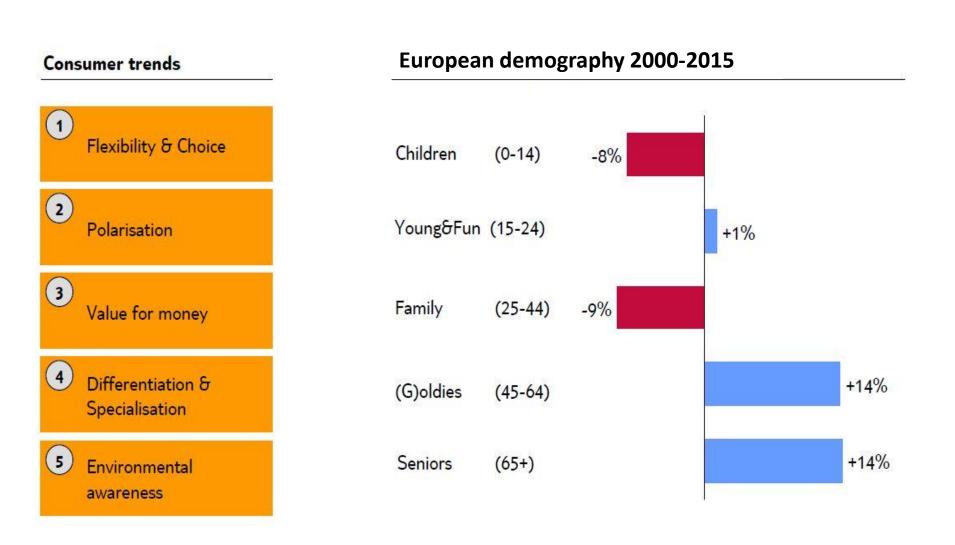

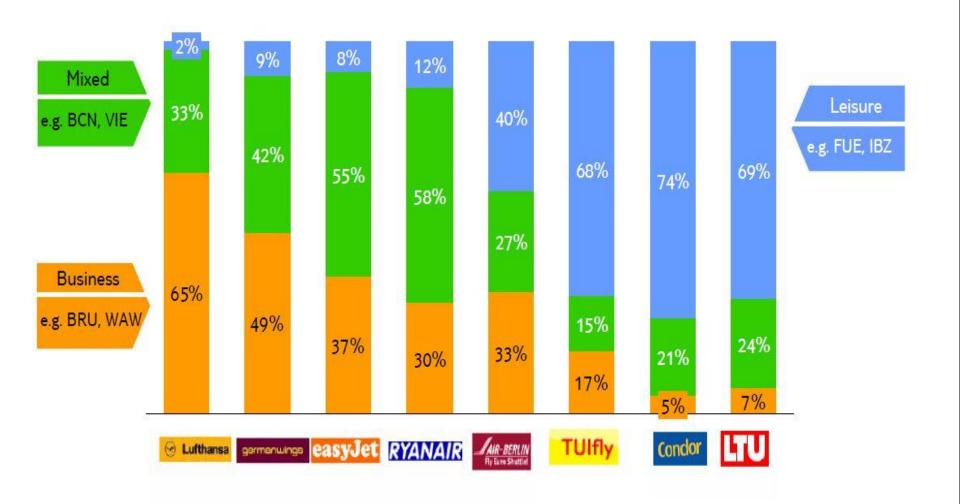


## Tourism in the digital world

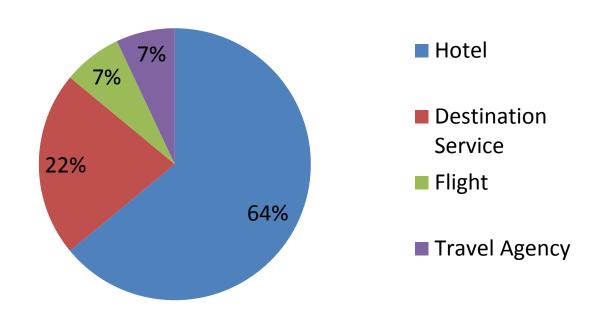
