Information Note

1. Place and dates of the session

In accordance with decision CE/DEC/8(CII) adopted by the Executive Council at its 102nd session in Medellín, Colombia, the Executive Council will hold its 103rd session on 9 to 11 May 2016 in Málaga, Spain, on the invitation of the Government of Spain, the State in which the Organization has its Headquarters. The working sessions of the Council will take place at the Trade Fairs and Congress Center of Málaga (http://www.fycma.com/). The opening ceremony, which will be followed by a welcome reception, will be held on Monday, 9 May 2016, at 8:30 p.m., at the Hacienda del Álamo.

3. Registration for the Council session

Registration for the Council session will open on 24 February and will be carried out online. Participants are requested to complete the registration form, available on the UNWTO website at http://lmd.unwto.org/event/executive-council-103rd-session, before Monday, 18 April 2016.



4. Status of participants

The Government of Spain will make the necessary arrangements to facilitate the arrival, stay and departure of all the participants invited by the Organization. During their stay, the participants will enjoy the privileges and immunities conferred to delegates at events of the UNWTO in Spain, in accordance with the provisions of the Headquarters Agreement of the UNWTO.

5. Entry formalities

The Government of Spain will grant visas free of charge to all delegates attending the 103rd session of the Executive Council, upon presentation of the letter of invitation to attend the Council session at the corresponding Embassy of Spain, in accordance with Spanish legislation.

<u>Important note:</u> Due to European Union regulations, <u>NO</u> visas-on-arrival can be issued. Participants are kindly requested to make the necessary arrangements to obtain their visas beforehand.

6. Access to Málaga

Málaga-Costa del Sol, located in the south of Spain, about 540 kilometres from Madrid, is easily accessible from anywhere in Spain and Europe, whether by plane, train or road.

The Málaga-Costa del Sol Airport is connected with the major cities of the world and is served by more than 50 airlines. The airport is located 8 km from the historic city centre.

Participants can also choose to travel by train to the Vialia-María Zambrano train station of Málaga. A high-speed train makes frequent trips between Madrid and Málaga with an approximate duration of 2.5 hours (www.renfe.com).

7. Reception at the airport and train station and transfers

The authorities of the host country will organize a reception service for participants at the Málaga airport and train station.

From 8 to 12 May, participants will be provided with a free shuttle service upon arrival and departure between the Málaga airport or the train station and the main hotels¹. To avail of this service, arrival and departure information must be provided when completing the online registration form.

To enable the Spanish authorities to properly organize the welcome and shuttle services, participants must complete and submit the online registration form (http://lmd.unwto.org/event/executive-council-103rd-session) indicating their arrival and departure flight information and their accommodation details, before 18 April 2016.

8. Accommodation

16. Practical information

- Local currency and exchange rates: The official currency of Spain is the euro (EUR). The exchange rate applicable in February 2016 is approximately 1.11 USD to 1 EUR.
 - Banks are open Monday to Friday from 8:30 to 14:00. Throughout Málaga there are currency exchange offices, which are clearly marked. There is also a currency exchange service in hotels. The city has numerous ATMs and shops accept major credit cards.
- Weather: In May, Málaga enjoys warm days and mild evenings. The average maximum temperature is 23 °C and the average minimum is 13 °C.
- Official language: Spanish
- Local time in Málaga (summer time): GMT +2
- Electricity: Electric power in Málaga is 220 volts, 50 hertz alternating current. Outlets take plugs with two round pins. In any case, most hotels have adaptors for different plug types. Please make sure that the electrical devices you will be using (computers, mobile phone chargers, electric shavers...) are suitable for this voltage, otherwise, transformers or batteries are advisable.
- Health requirements and precautions: No vaccinations are required to enter Spain.
- Medical services: Málaga has a good network of health centres (primary care services) and hospitals. The venue of the meeting will have a medical service providing first aid.
- Local transport rates: Taxi rides to and from the airport cost between 15 and 25 euros.
 Fares for local buses are €1.30 for a single ride and 10-ride tickets can be purchased for €8.30.
- Optional visits: There will be a travel agency desk at Trade Fairs and Congress Center to provide information on optional visits.

17. Tourist information

Visiting Málaga and the Costa del Sol is synonymous with beautiful landscapes, fabulous beaches, delicious cuisine and unique traditions. It means discovering an extensive cultural heritage, dazzling coastlines and the charm of the whitewashed villages of the interior. Many surprising treasures await the visitor, ensuring an unforgettable experience.

For culture lovers, visiting the historical, artistic and architectural heritage of Málaga means discovering a unique cultural legacy. The cultural offerings are rounded out by theatres, museums, exhibition centres and concerts halls that feature diverse and interesting programming.

The area's 784 heritage elements that have been officially declared to be of "Cultural Interest" include monuments, archaeological sites and historical places, in addition to the vibrant cultural scene, make Málaga and the Costa del Sol a must-visit destination for culture lovers. Among the most emblematic sites that no visitor should miss are the Tajo de Ronda, the Balcón de Europa in Nerja and the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria, located in Antequera.

For lovers of nature and adventure tourism, Málaga and the Costa del Sol offer a wealth of cultural and environmental attractions set in the beautiful landscapes of Málaga's interior. Monument sites, natural areas and lands steeped in history, tradition and legend constitute a reality that reveals the most authentic aspect of the province.

Places like the Bosque de Cobre, the Fuente de Piedra lagoon, the Torcal de Antequera Nature Area, the canyons of the Desfiladero de Los Gaitanes or the Great Málaga Path are sure to delight nature lovers.

More than 70 golf courses make Málaga and Costa del Sol the leading golf travel destination in Europe. This has earned the area the nickname 'Costa del Golf'. In addition to its top-notch infrastructure for golfers, Málaga province is blessed with an ideal climate that makes it possible to play all year round.
