<u>Aware that</u> Canada and Greece, both of which have contributed significantly to the Organization's programmes and activities, are interested in serving as Chairman of the Executive Council,

<u>Recalling</u> the statements made by the delegates of Canada and Greece in support of their respective candidatures,

Noting that Greece has designated Professor Marios Raphael to perform the duties of Chairman,

<u>Having heard</u> from the Canadian delegation that, in the interest of consensus, Canada withdraws its candidature on this occasion,

Thanks Canada for its gesture;

- 2. <u>Elects</u> Greece unanimously as its Chairman for the year 1994;
- 3. <u>Invites</u> Professor Marios Raphael to take the chair and preside over the remaining deliberations of its forty-seventh session; and
- 4. <u>Elects</u> Morocco and Tunisia as first and second Vice-Chairman, respectively, for the year 1994.

Having further regard to rule 32(1) of its Rules of Procedure,
