Decision 1 (III)

Progress Report of the Secretary-General

Agenda item 2 (document CE/3/2)

The Executive Council,

Takes note of the progress report of the Secretary-General covering the period since the second session of the Council.

Decision 2(III)

Members of the Organization

Agenda item 3 (document CE/3/3)

The Executive Council,

Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General on the membership of the Organization and on applications for membership.

Decision 3 (III)

Report on financial matters: interim administrative accounts for the financial year 1976, and current financial position

Agenda item 4 (document CE/3/4)

The Executive Council,

Having taken note of the report of the Secretary-General on the interim administrative accounts and the current financial position of the Organization,

Expresses its serious concern about the delay of some Full and Affiliate Members of the Organization in paying their contribu-

Entrusts the Secretary-General with taking all appropriate measures to ensure that these contributions are paid as soon as possible and with reporting back to it at its next session;

Having considered the applications made by certain member States for contribution adjustments pursuant to General Assembly decision 17 (I).

Decides to recommend to the General Assembly that the contributions of Cyprus and Nicaragua to the Organization's budget for the financial years 1976 and 1977 should be fixed at the level of the lowest contribution of Full Members of the Organization;

Decides to recommend to the General Assembly that the contribution of San Marino to the Organization's budget for the financial years 1976 and 1977 and for all the financial years to come should be fixed at the level of the lowest contribution of Full Members of the Organization; to a light MELED of the Administra

Entrusts the Secretary-General with reporting to it at its next session on the reasons put forward by Costa Rica, El Salvador, Panama and the Holy See for their applications for contribution adjustments.

The Executive Council,

Having taken note of the proposals of the Secretary-General for carrying appropriations forward from the financial year 1976 to the financial year 1977,

Considering the provisions of the Financial Regulations,

Authorizes the Secretary-General to carry forward where justified, appropriations from the first to the second financial year of each financial period and entrusts him with reporting to the Committee on Budget and Finance;

Decides that any appropriations wholly or partly unspent at the end of the first financial year of each financial period which it would not be justified to carry forward shall be paid into a special banking account and may be utilized with the authorization of the Council, on the proposal of the Secretary-General.

Report of the Working Party on the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, the Executive Council, the Technical Committee for Programme and Coordination (TCPC) and the Committee on Budget and Finance (CBF)

Agenda item 8 (document CE/3/8)

The Executive Council,

Approves the report of the Working Party on the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, the Executive Council, the Technical Committee for Programme and Coordination (TCPC) and the Committee on Budget and Finance (CBF);

Decides to transmit to the General Assembly, as it was entrusted with doing, the draft Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly as contained in Annex II to document CE/3/8, supplemented by the relevant provisions contained in document CE/3/8 Add. 1, it being understood that:

- (a) the "original text" of rule 38 (2) should be retained and a new subparagraph inserted after subparagraph (c) worded as follows: "matters involving budgetary and financial obligations of the Members";
- (b) a new paragraph (3) should be added to rule 38, worded as follows: Decisions concerning the admission of new Members shall be taken by a majority of two-thirds of the Full Members present and voting provided that said majority is a majority of the Full Members of the Organization;

Adopts its own Rules of Procedure as contained in Annex III to document CE/3/8, supplemented by the provisions contained in document CE/3/8 Add. 1, it being understood that:

- (a) rule 5 (3) is to read: "The Chairman and the Vice-Chairmen shall be eligible for a second term of office";
- (b) the "original text" of rule 27 (2) is to be retained;

Decides that, in accordance with rule 8 (2) of its own Rules of Procedure, these shall be applicable, <u>mutatis mutandis</u>, to its subsidiary organs and that any modifications proposed by those organs shall be submitted to it for approval.

- (b) paragraph (b) of rule 15 is to be deleted.

Decides that the terms of reference of the Working Party shall be:

- (a) to make recommendations concerning the Organization's policy for the regionalization of certain activities;
- (b) to make recommendations concerning the most appropriate regional structures for achieving the Organization's aims, specifying if possible the spheres of competence, terms of reference, and operating methods of such structures;
- (c) to study, where appropriate, the most suitable composition of regional bodies for meeting the tourism requirements, interests and goals of groups of countries;

Invites Pakistan and Yugoslavia to act as Chairman and Vice-Chairman, respectively, of the Working Party;

Appoints as members of the Working Party: Bangladesh, Belgium, Cameroon, France, Lebanon, Nigeria, Panama, Poland, Senegal, Thailand, the Chairman of the Technical Committee for Programme and Coordination (TCPC), the Chairman of the Committee on Budget and Finance (CBF), and the Chairman of the Committee of Affiliate Members (CAM):

Decides that the Working Party shall meet at Headquarters during March 1977 and that its sittings will be open to all the Members of the Council.

Entrusts the Secretary-General with reporting to it at its next session on the budgetary implications of preparing and holding the Conference with respect to organization, material arrangements, and staff.
