Item 1. Adoption of the agenda (document CE/108/1 prov.)

(a) Financial report of the Organization for 2018 (document CE/108/7(a))

A report is submitted on the current financial situation of the Organization and the outlook for the next several months.

The Council is called upon to approve proposed amendments to Detailed Financial Rules Annex I - Travel guidelines.

(b) UNWTO financial report and audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2017 (document CE/108/7(b))

A report is submitted on the administrative accounts for 2017, together with the relevant financial statements. It includes the report made by the Organization's auditors designated by Spain (Member elected to this post by the General Assembly in resolution A/RES/661(XXI)).

The Council is called upon to approve the revisions and transfers made in Regular Budget appropriations in 2017 and to issue a recommendation to the General Assembly regarding the approval of the UNWTO Financial Statements for 2017.

(c) Application of Article 34 of the Statutes and paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules (document CE/108/7(c) and CE/108/7(c) Add. 1)

The Secretary-General reports to the Council on the application of General Assembly resolution A/RES/682(XXII) concerning the provisions of Article 34 of the Statutes. He provides the Council with a list of Members subject to the provisions of paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules attached to the Statutes. He also reports on compliance with the conditions of payment by Members benefiting from suspension of the provisions of paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules.

The Council is called upon to consider the approval of payment plans as well as the granting and maintenance of temporary exceptions.

(d) Membership status (document CE/108/7(d))

The Secretary-General reports on the situation of the Organization's membership and updates the Council on the Secretariat's efforts to expand membership in the Organization.

(e) Human resources report (document CE/108/7(e))

The Secretary-General informs the Council on the structure and human resources situation of the Secretariat.

Under this item, an amendment to the Staff Rules, Chapter X - Disciplinary Measures, is proposed for approval by the Council.

Item 8. Affiliate Members

(a) Report of the Chair of the Affiliate Members (document CE/108/8(a))

The Chair of the Affiliate Members informs the Council of the courses of action and decisions adopted with a view to further developing the activities of the Affiliate Members and public-private cooperation at the UNWTO.
