II. Implementation of the General Programme of Work, document CE/108/5(c) rev. 1

V. UNWTO financial report and audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2017, document CE/108/7(b)

7. The Secretary-General presented the UNWTO financial report and audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2017. The PBC took note with appreciation of the unqualified opinion of the External Auditors to the UNWTO 2017 Financial Statements and requested the Executive Council to recommend the General Assembly to approve the UNWTO financial report and audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2017.

VI. Application of Article 34 of the Statutes and paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules, document CE/108/7(c)

8. The Secretary-General presented the updated report on the Members falling under the abovementioned provisions, thanking those that have made the necessary efforts in order to fulfil their financial obligations and reminding Members of the importance of settling their contributions to the budget within the time period stipulated thereby averting delays that could hamper programme execution.
