13 May 2017: First human cemetery in Middle Egypt, with 17 mummies at Tuna al-Gebel, Minya






9 september 2017: Tomb of the goldsmith
“Amenemhat”, at Draa abu al-Naga, Luxor




15 October 2017: Remains of a temple of
Ramses II, Abusir




9 December 2017: Tomb at Draa Abu al-Naga, Luxor

1 August 2018: The burial chambers of Remu-Shenti and Baqet II, Beni Hassan, Minya


10 November 2018: Three tombs dating back to the New Kingdom reused during the Late Period as animals cemetery,


